Jurisprudence

- Cancellation Court of Appeal of Florida, a \$ 4.8 million ruling against clients residing in France to a procedural flaw in the notification of the hearing. Matejka v. Dulaney, 40 So. 3d 865 (Fla. 4th DCA 2010).
